Affirming Diversity

A one day workshop for teachers, nurses and community workers focused on teaching about sexual orientation and gender identity, based on the teaching resource.

Alcohol and Sexuality

A one day workshop on alcohol and its impact on sexual health and behaviour, based on the secondary school teaching resource.

The “A” Word - how to teach about abortion

A one day workshop for teachers and school based professionals focused on teaching about the sensitive topic of abortion, includes use of teaching resource.

The “A” Word – talking about abortion with young people

A one day workshop for professionals working with young people – youth and community workers, counsellors, youth health providers.

The Colours of Sexuality

A one day workshop for secondary school teachers of young people with mild to moderate learning disabilities, based on teaching resource.

The Elephant in the Room

A half day workshop for teachers, community workers and those working with youth on talking and teaching about pleasure.

Getting Started

A one day introduction to teaching sexuality to young people.

Hei Huarahi

A one day workshop for secondary teachers and those working in secondary alternative education settings and teaching about sexuality and relationships to years 9 and 10, based on the teaching resources.

Keep Safe

A one day workshop on teaching contraception and sexually transmissible infections at secondary school level.

Preparing for Puberty

A one day workshop for primary and intermediate teachers, school nurses and community workers who teach young people about pubertal change.

Sexuality and Intellectual Disability for Care and Support Staff

An introductory level workshop, for those working with people with an intellectual disability, focused on supporting the development of healthy and positive sexualities.

Sexuality and Young Men

A one day workshop about sexuality and gender for professionals working with young men.

Sexuality Education for Years One to Four

A one day workshop for teachers of Years One to Four, introducing the Ka puāwai, ka hiki ki te haere resource.

The Sexuality Road - Discovering Me

One day workshop focused on how to use The Sexuality Road resource for teaching sexuality and pubertal change to young people from years 5-8.
