Tikanga Ririki is a unique strengths-based Maori parenting model developed by Maori child advocacy agency Mana Ririki. Based on pre-colonial Maori parenting values, Tikanga Ririki is evidencing profound changes in Maori whanau. WAVES and Mana Ririki are implementing the model in Waitakere and offering newly-updated Train-The-Facilitator workshops for:

- Anyone interested in Maori parenting and tikanga Maori practice models;
- Providers delivering parenting training to Maori whanau.

Training dates and costs

For anyone with an interest in Maori parenting \$150.00 plus GST

One-day Introductory Workshop 24 June

Learn about the beliefs about tamariki found in Maori mythology, and how whanau can apply these values to contemporary parenting.

For workers progressing through to accreditation \$600.00 plus GST

Two-day Introductory Workshop 24 & 25 June

After introducing you to Maori beliefs about tamariki, you will practice working with Tikanga Ririki training materials.

Supervision Seminar 25 September

During the three-month interval, you will facilitate the Parenting Course with whanau you work with. This Supervision seminar will review your experience of the Course.

Accreditation Forum 4 December

The final day will review and evaluate your progress. You will then be certified to deliver Tikanga Ririki training, use all the attendant resources, and confirm support contacts.
